Re: New computerized payment System for Lunch

The Food Service Staff evaluated many different computerized Point of Service systems. We have purchased the Nutri-Kids POS System. The first day of service will be sometime after January 18, 2005.

The first few days the lunch line may be slower, but as the students familiarize themselves with the system, the lines should move much quicker than before.

Every student at Blue Springs Schools has been entered into the computerized system. Students can pay in cash. However, we strongly recommend parents/guardians deposit money into the student's account. Make sure and write your child's name or student ID number (same number as on their grade card) on your check or envelope.

If your child has qualified for free or reduced price lunches, this information is in the system, and the meal will be processed just as it is for all other students.

If you are concerned about a food allergy that your son/daughter has, please notify the cafeteria with this information. A warning will appear on the cashiers' screen for a review of the items on the student's tray.
