

Eligibility - Interscholastic Activities are open to all 8th graders. (7th Graders may participate in Cross Country). At the beginning of the school year 7th grade students are academically eligible to participate when they are promoted to that grade. 8th grade students are eligible to participate upon promotion to that grade. However, any student entering 8th grade who failed more than one scheduled subject shall be ineligible the following grading period regardless of promotion to the higher grade.

Student eligibility may be reinstated the **FIRST** grading period eligibility for a student being promoted to the 8th grade who has failed more than one class but no more than three classes if the student passes the appropriate number of core classes through secondary school-sponsored summer school. (i.e. if a student fails three classes at the end of the preceding grading term but passes two core classes in summer school that student is eligible to participate in interscholastic activities during the first grading period of the school year.)

Students who have two or more "F's" on any six-week grade report shall be ineligible to participate until the end of the succeeding six week grading period. Students become eligible when their grade card has no more than one grade of "F" recorded on it. See MSHSAA By-laws 2.37 & 2.3.9 or call the school's athletic director for more information.

Participation in Interscholastic Sports - on the 1st day of practice you must have a properly signed physical form and proof of medical insurance.
